YEAR 3 TRIP TO CROMER MUSEUM FOR DEEP HISTORY COAST (FOSSILS) WORKSHOP
WEDNESDAY 27TH NOVEMBER 2024

During this term the children in Year 3 will be studying rocks and fossils as part of their Science topic. To enrich this topic the children will be visiting Cromer museum to learn about:

- Common Norfolk fossil finds
- Identification of fossils
- Handle and classify fossils
- A visit to the geology gallery

Children will need to be in school at the normal time of 8.40 am and we will be back at school by 3.10pm.

The cost of this trip is £16.00 which includes coach travel, entry to the museum and workshops run by the museum staff. Payment and consent for this trip should be made via Parentmail by **Friday 22nd November**. Please contact Mrs Drake in the Office if you have any problems with Parentmail.

Children will need to wear their school uniform but will need to wear a suitable warm/waterproof coat and sturdy footwear as we will spend some of the time on the beach. A packed lunch and drink will also be required. If you are entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided (please let the office know if your child would like this by **Monday 25th November** (stating whether they require a ham or cheese roll). Any medication or inhalers must be in a sealed bag or container with the child's name and class clearly marked.
