Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are reading The Girl who Stole an Elephant as a class.

English:

In English we are learning to write stories from other cultures and returning to persuasive writing with adverts.

Maths:

In Maths we will be focussing on multiplication and division, length and perimeter.

Science:

Our science topic this half term is classification and the environment.

Topic:

Geography

We are investigating the physical and human geography of South America.

Art/DT:

We will be looking at sculpture and 3D materials.

Music:

We will be studying how to use music to explore your feelings as you play.

PE:

We will be practising gymnastics and hockey this term.

PSHE:

We will be discussing health, wellbeing and safety.

RE:

Our key question this half term is why is there a diversity of opinion within Christianity?

Computing:

We will be learning about online safety and investigating creating media using technology.

Homework

Each week, your child will receive:

- As the weather is now cold, your child will need to bring a waterproof coat with them to school each day.
- Please make sure your child has a water bottle with them every day containing only water.
