Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are reading: Street Beneath my Feet, Rhythm of the Rain and Little People, Big Dreams: David Attenborough.

English:

In English we are learning to write stories from other cultures and a recount from personal experience.

Maths:

We will be focusing on multiplication and division, addition and subtraction. We will be learning how to use the column method and learning the 3- and 4-times tables.

Science:

Our science topic this half term is Rocks and Fossils.

Topic:

History

We are focusing on the Stone Age, Bronze Age and the Iron Age.

Art:

Painting – mixed media prehistoric art.

Music:

Writing Down Music.

PE:

Fundamentals and tag rugby.

We are focusing on Economic wellbeing.

Our Big Question this half term is, How people express commitment to a religion/worldview in different ways?

Each week, your child will receive:

These need to be practised daily.

In addition to this, there will be a half termly homework set on Class Dojo. This will be related to our Science unit.

- Reading books need to be brought into school **every day** as we will be using them at 8.40 for individual readers
- As the weather is starting to get colder, your child will need to bring a **waterproof coat** with them to school each day.
- Please make sure your child has a **water bottle** with them every day containing only water.
