YEAR 3 TRIP - "ANCIENT EGYPTIANS: DISCOVERY AND DEBATE"
AT NORWICH CASTLE MUSEUM TUESDAY 2ND JULY

During this term the children in Year 3 have been studying the Ancient Egyptians. As part of the topic, a trip has been arranged to take part in an "Ancient Egyptians: Discovery and Debate" day at the Castle Museum, in Norwich on Tuesday 2nd July. Children will need to be in school at the normal time of 8.45am and we will be back at school by 3.10pm. If any parents would like to volunteer for this trip then please do let us know, it is always wonderful to have additional adults to support the children.

The cost of this trip is £13.00 which includes coach travel, entry to the museum and workshops run by the museum staff. Payment and consent for this trip should be made via Parentmail by Friday 28th June. Please contact Mrs Drake in the Office if you have any problems with Parentmail.

Children will need to wear their school uniform and will need to bring a coat with them. A packed lunch will also be required and we are encouraging pupils to bring an Egyptian style lunch to fit in with the theme of the day (see attached information for Egyptian lunch ideas). If you are entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided (please let the office know if your child would like this, stating whether they require a ham or cheese roll). Any medication or inhalers must be in a sealed bag or container with the child's name and class clearly marked.
