


Year 5 Newsletter Summer 2 2023/24



Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are continuing with reading as a class *The Last Wild by Piers Torday*, as well as completing Runaway Robot by Frank Cotterell Boyce **English:**

In English we are studying a new text, The Last Wild by Piers Torday where we will be continuing the story by extending the plot and also poetry around the theme of the book. We will also be covering SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and hand writing throughout our English lessons. Our reading skill development will be based around our science and topic texts along with vocabularly development. **Maths:**

In Maths we will be learning to add and subtract decimals, measurement: mass, capacity and length, negative numbers and converting units and recapping our arithmetic skills.

Our science topic will be Getting Older.
